

Positive Classroom Environment Helps STUDENTS THRIVE DESPITE THE PANDEMIC

e might have heard individuals say the following statements, and we wondered what were they referring to?

"Oh, my stars!"

"COVID was quite a year!"

"Schools certainly are struggling to ensure their students are paying attention!"

Come to think of it, those are all true sentences. In fact, we should revisit each one. However, first, the actual intended answers to what *Oh, my stars!* might mean.

My stars is how several teachers greet students every morning at Self Development Academy (SDA). Teachers welcome the students and set the tone for positive interactions.

STAR, a term from the book, *Teach Like a Champion*, by Doug Lemov, is actually an acronym for proper student conduct we emphasize at SDA. And we use it to refer to our students displaying the following behavior:

Sit tall

Track the speaker Ask and answer questions Respect those around you.

Indeed, teaching during COVID was quite a year. Last year, students across the country were never asked to Sit up tall, Track the speaker, Ask or answer

Our nation's entire student body spent a year in childtime learning on their own terms and mostly remotely. At SDA, as the students returned in person, we had to be ready to motivate students to be engaged in their quest for acquiring knowledge. We aimed to provide SDA students





with more opportunities for learning. We did not just add a few interventions to improve learning. We worked hard to find solutions exponentially to make up for the student learning loss and improve student morale.

Although students at some schools have struggled with paying attention in school, Self Development Academy has good news for students attending in-person learning: student morale is up. The Education Week Research Center Student survey (Sept./Oct. 2021) validates SDA's observation. The Education Week's survey based on the perceptions of educators reports that student morale is up, especially in schools that have held more in-person learning.

At SDA, for the current year and the coming year, we are resuming our diverse catalogue of courses. We have already implemented our own handcrafted and adaptive learning programs for children. Why? Because we cannot really blame children who find remote learning less than thoroughly bewitching. Students are experiencing severe learning gaps.

It is our responsibility as educators to identify where our children are academically, and it is our responsibility for teaching them to reach high levels of academic achievement. This year, our programs will allow the students to soar through a kaleidoscope of critical and creative thinking programs, mindfulness, coding, and music and art.

We are even going further to ensure that we continue to maintain curious, captivated, attentive students who possess SDA's high motivation levels for learning. High levels of motivation need high levels of student morale. To improve student morale, we designed a program that moves the needle toward motivated students through peergenerated positive reinforcement.


Our program provides persistent positive reinforcement of students' good behaviors by their peers. The positive recognition by their peers helps our students to know just how spectacular they are and just how infinitely promising their lives can be.

Additionally, SDA is boosting students' morale by engaging students in a plethora of ways by focusing on their well-being and safety. By providing a supportive and nurturing environment, students look forward to attending school, enjoy hanging around with their friends at school, and learn to collaborate with their friends, and show respect to their teachers. Students are engaged in their learning.

At SDA, each day, the teacher greets them enthusiastically by saying, "Hello, my STARS." Students, in turn, develop self-discipline and confidence to achieve success. The students believe that they are creative, thoughtful, philosophizing students. The teacher's message is heard loud and clear: "My incurably curious students, my STAR students, my high achievers."

ax laws are constantly changing and the current proposals, if passed, will have significant changes to tax rates, tax brackets, and the treatment of retirement plans.

With all of the proposed changes, it would

Some of the advantages of a Roth retirement account over a pretax retirement account are that earnings in the Roth account are exempt from income tax and if the account is a Roth IRA, there is no requirement for required minimum distributions (RMDs).

Current tax law changes that are being proposed would increase tax rates, potentially limit Roth conversions in the future, as well as eliminate some allowable contributions to Roth accounts. The proposals also include a reduction of the lifetime estate tax exemption from \$11,700,000 to either half that amount or even as low as \$3,500,000.

over a period of years by taking advantage of the tax brackets and by performing a dollar-cost averaging of your investment portfolio.

Performing a Roth conversion is not only an investment issue, it is a tax issue and an estate planning issue. The timing of the conversion, timing of tax payments, and other administrative issues should all be considered prior to the conversion. 

Understanding the Buyer and Seller Closing Costs

7hether you are the buyer or seller, there are closing costs that need to be paid at closing and knowing these fees up front and what to expect will help you be prepared and

not have any last-minute surprises. Fees will vary between lenders, loan type and terms, and title companies.

FOR THE SELLER

The two Sellers Closing Costs Estimates below are based on fees from Security Title. Remember, fees will vary between title companies, but this gives you an idea of what fees to expect when selling a home in Mesa (taxes will vary by city). This is before any payoff of your current mortgage(s).

- Sales price of \$400,000 and \$800,000
- Close of escrow date of November 15
- Seller paying the Home Warranty
- Standard realtor commissions of six percent, split three percent for listing agent and three percent for selling agent





Your realtor can provide you with a closing cost estimate at any time. 



The rewards of these experiences motivate him to practice these same quality-of-life improvement principles for his current patients in Arizona.

Fast-forward to a recent situation with an Arizona patient who recently had to quit her job due to her inability to see because of early-onset cataracts. After receiving cataract surgery, her vision was greatly improved to the point of being able to return to work. The patient has reported that she feels like she has her life back again.

Situations like these, and from prior experiences in Ghana, have reminded Dr. Birdsong that vision is truly much more than seeing. Sight has the potential to change a person's outlook literally and metaphorically on life.

Dr. Birdsong is quick to give credit, where credit is due, for the journey that has turned his profession into his dream. "I was extremely lucky to be born to two amazing parents who worked multiple jobs providing for my sister and I to give us a better life than they had. They taught me how to work hard from an early age and that foundation shaped me today."

Professionally, he recognizes his residency director, Dr. Kevin Merkley, and his fellowship director, Dr. Majid Moshirfar, for teaching him the nuances, and the do's and the don'ts of the field of ophthalmology for which he is truly grateful.

The Benefits of Play Encourage Learning

arents, grandparents, and caregivers play a special role in helping young learners develop literacy skills. There are a variety of ways families can engage young children in the home, helping them become lifelong learners.

According to Trisha Pemberton, early learning specialist at Mesa Public Schools, research shows play is an important key to early literacy. Children need to play because it activates all parts of the brain, helping them build executive function skills, and triggers curiosity or inquiry skills. Play helps children develop social, language, and communication skills. It also builds confidence and makes children feel loved. By simply talking, reading, or singing together, caretakers can support their child's early learning.

"Children are successful when they are engaged in doing what their brains are designed to do, which is playing," Trisha says. "During play, children develop language skills and vocabulary. It's also when social norms and rules can be more easily taught because they make sense to children."







Looking for ways to support young learners? Here are a few tips from Trisha:

- Sing and dance together. Singing can introduce young children to new vocabulary words in a fun way.
- Play with your young learner, whether it's drawing, make-believe, or another fun activity. These interactions help children develop and understand language.
- Celebrate your family history. Create beautiful interactions in the kitchen, cooking special foods, and sharing a story about a cultural family tradition.
- Share a favorite memory and ask the child to share one of their favorite memories. Are there familial things that happen when a grandmother or uncle visits? How does the family engage? It's in these pieces that children develop a robust vocabulary.
- Read a favorite book together. Ask your child to select the book and have them share why it is special. Provide opportunities for young children to voice their preferences.
- Share a time as a child when it may have been challenging to learn something. Empower your children by encouraging them to ask questions. Maybe they want to know why grandpa has big ears. They aren't being disrespectful, it's their way of using their inquiry skills. ■





Medicare Annual Enrollment is On


